

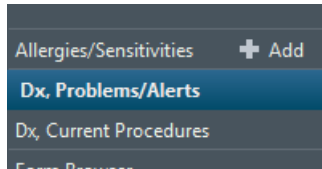

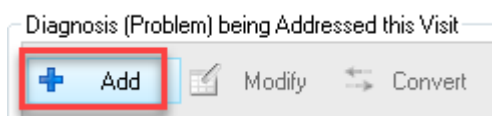
COVID-19 - Document Diagnosis

Once a patient has a positive diagnosis for COVID-19 / SARS-COV2, a diagnosis should be added to the patient's chart.

1. Select 'Dx Problems/Alerts' from the Navigation bar



2. Under diagnosis, select 'Add'



3. Type the diagnosis into the yellow field and click the binoculars to see a list of options with SNOMED codes attached
