Background

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic there has been an increased demand for PPE throughout Western Health. The health and safety of all staff members is a top priority for the organisation. Western Health wants to ensure that all staff have timely access to PPE and that all areas of the hospital have adequate stock required for staff to perform their job safely. This new process will ensure the health and safety of staff by being accountable for PPE usage which will preserve critical PPE for as long as possible.

As an established supply of PPE is now available through DHHS; Western Health is beginning the transition back to business as usual ordering processes. Steps will be taken as supply teams are able to adjust ordering processes.

Goal

To begin the transition of restricted stores ordering back to ward/area led; with the support of the PPE Clinical Coordinators and Supply and Logistics teams.

Ordering Process:

1. Area Manager/NUM/ANUM will be required to complete the order template and email to PPE team by 10am the day prior to order being received – noting delivery days are set for ward areas. Please note there are order limits on some items. The PPE Clinical Coordinators team are required to monitor usage rates and audit usage as required.
2. Orders must be clearly labelled with location and area contact phone number to ensure timely and accurate delivery.
