

# Arriving at the Parkville Precinct COVID-19 Staff Vaccination Hub

## Arriving at the Royal Melbourne Hospital

When arriving at the Parkville Precinct COVID-19 Staff Vaccination Hub, you will be required to present yourself to screening staff at either of the RMH entrances.

If you have previously filled in the daily attestation at one of the four precinct hospitals, please provide proof such as a text message or screening sticker to staff.

If you have not checked-in, please make yourself familiar with the visitor QR codes displayed at the entrances to answer the screening questions online. Once you've completed this, please make your way to the Function Centre on ground floor near the centre lifts.

## How to get to the vaccination hub

Please make yourself known to vaccination hub staff who will be happy to assist you with your COVID-19 vaccination appointment.

Be sure to arrive to the Parkville Precinct COVID-19 Staff Vaccination Hub 10 minutes prior to your appointment. Please have your organisational staff ID with you.

There is a limited supply of vaccines so if you're unable to make your appointment, please contact Immunisation Coordinator, Yvette Spero at [Yvette.spero@mh.org.au](mailto:Yvette.spero@mh.org.au) as soon as possible.

Please note: parking can be difficult, please give yourself extra time.
