

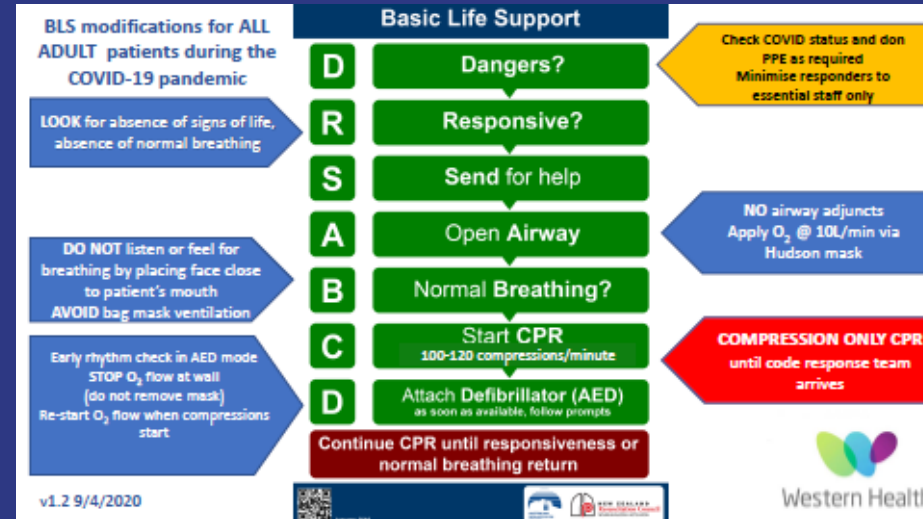

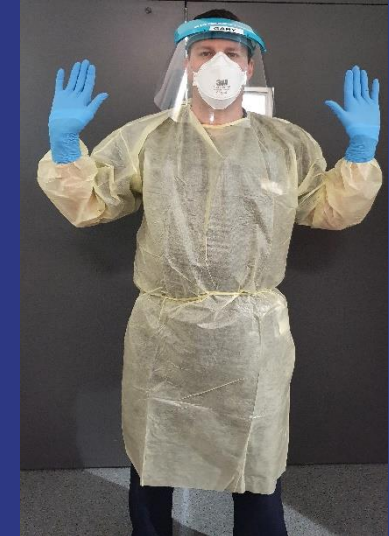


Commence COVID-19 modified adult BLS

# PPE FOR ADULT CODE BLUES- ALS Code Responders

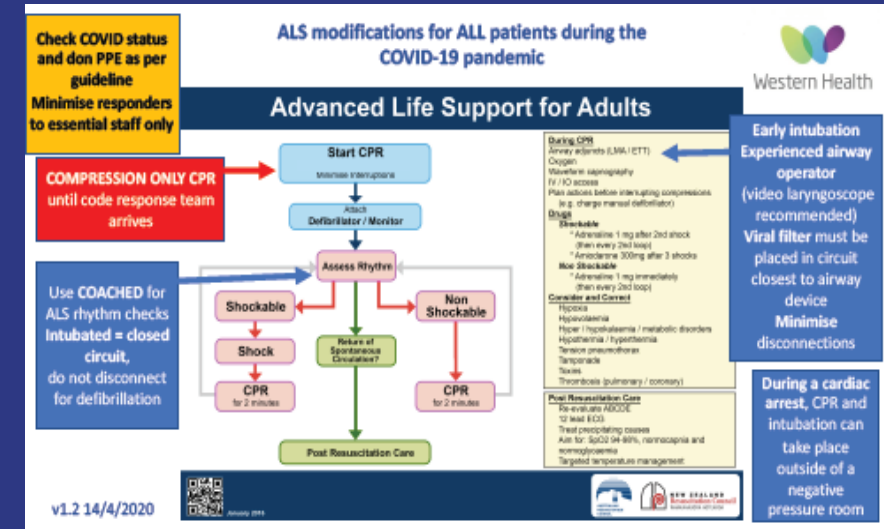
## Code Blue Team (Advanced Life Support)

- P2/N95 mask
- Face shield,
- Disposable long sleeved (yellow) gown
- gloves
- Hand hygiene to above the elbow afterwards.
