

How to order personal protective equipment mirrors

Personal protective (PPE) mirrors


In 2020 PPE mirrors were piloted in clinical areas at Sunshine Hospital to determine whether staff found them useful to don and doff their PPE including gown, gloves, eye protection and mask. Overall 86% of staff found the mirrors helped them to don and doff their PPE safely. Following the successful pilot, PPE mirrors have been installed in clinical areas across Western Health.

What sizes and type of mirror are available?

Two PPE mirror sizes are available, a small mirror (600 x 450mm) and a long mirror (1200 x 350mm). The small mirror can support staff to don and doff their eye protection and mask, whereas the long mirror can support staff to don and doff their gown, gloves, eye protection and mask. The mirror design complies with OH&S standards and is of a non-breakable design.

Where are the PPE mirrors installed?

The PPE mirrors are installed on the wall at donning or doffing stations. The suggested installation dimensions of the small and long mirrors are reflected in the pictures below.



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How do I organise PPE mirrors for my clinical area?

Please work with your manager and team to determine how many small and/ or long mirrors you would like installed. Also determine where the mirrors would be installed. To order the mirrors please request this via the COVID Logistics Team Covid19-Logistics2@wh.org.au, stating how many small and/ or long mirrors you would like to order.

Once you are notified that the mirrors have arrived, please complete a BEIMS request for the mirrors to be installed.

How do I mark out where we want the mirrors to be installed?
