

Children of Staff – Priority Access COVID-19 Vaccination

COVID-19 VACCINATION HUB



This document outlines the process for priority access to COVID-19 vaccine for children of Western Health staff aged 5 – 11 years.

To facilitate the implementation of the National COVID-19 vaccine program, ATAGI recommends vaccination of children aged between 5 and 11 years. All Western Health staff with children aged between 5 and 11 years will be given priority access to vaccination at one of our Western Health COVID-19 Vaccination Hubs, including:

- Sunshine Hospital
- Melton Indoor and Drive Through

Walk-ins for paediatric vaccinations will not be available and an appointment must be made.

Bookings are planned to be available through the Department of Health call centre from early January. Appointments will be made by calling 1800 675 398, 7 days a week, 8 am to 8 pm.

Bookings through the Department of Health online portal are not likely to be available until the end of January.

Priority child appointments will be available from the 10th January for staff to make a booking.
